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## Format and Rules

The basic concept of “taking a seat for sight” promotes a committed level of support for the visually impaired community. This event will offer a day of engaging entertainment that is mission-aligned, with a fun, relay-style format that fosters a fun, competitive spirit. This event is designed for all ages and abilities to participate, including the visually impaired.

### How it works:

1. Participants are asked to register as part of a team of four or as a single individual.
2. Individuals may participate without a team of four, but are asked to attend and participate for the duration of the event.
3. Participants may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets. Reminder: Pledge sheets need to be turned in no later than the day of the event - November 12, 2011.
4. As a participant you may elect to be a team leader or a team member. All participants are required to pay an entry fee of \$25.00 each. This can be money pledged on your behalf or paid by you directly.
5. On the day of the event, participants may choose to attend the entire event and sit for multiple hours (maximum 4) or sit for one of the four “legs,” which will be divided by hours seated.
6. Teams of four or more can participate in a relay format, allowing one person to sit for one hour and then pass their seat to the next team member, or as a team seated for the entire duration of the event.
7. You can collect a pledge amount for each hour seated by using the pledge form included in this packet.
8. Each of the four “legs” (hours) of the event will involve participants seated for sight while engaging in fun entertainment, trivia, and spirited competition.
9. Pledges may be made by anyone. Please ask everyone who pledges if their company has a matching gift fund policy, and if so, please use the attached matching gift pledge sheet to capture their pledge information.
10. Each sponsor making a pledge must provide their name, address, email, pledge amount per hour, and amount paid to participant.
11. Please return pledge sheets with all money collected to staff and volunteers of Enight Skills Center at or before the event on November 12, 2011.
12. All pledge monies must be collected and turned into Enight Skills Center by Wednesday, November 16<sup>th</sup>.
